



**Restoule Local Services Board (RLSB)
Special Community Meeting – July 27, 2019 at 11:00 am
Allocation of Funds from the Oil Leak Legal Settlement**

On Saturday morning a Community meeting was held to discuss the wishes of the Community related to the allocation of \$181,316.62 received as a result of the Community Centre Oil Leak Legal Settlement. The Chair of the RLSB, Glenn Scanlan facilitated the meeting presentation and discussion.

In the 2019 Newsletter the Restoule Community Property Owners were asked to submit their suggestions regarding the allocation of the Funds prior to this special meeting. The requests were then compiled as Operational Requests and Capital Requests. The Capital Requests were further subdivided by requests related to the Community Centre Building, the Fire Hall, the Legion Building and Community at large initiatives.

Mr. Scanlan reviewed the Power Point Slides providing background information on the requested items as well as fielding questions and facilitating the discussion from the floor. During deliberations a few additional suggestions were brought forward to be added to the list while two items were not supported for consideration. After a very healthy discussion from those present at the meeting, consensus was reached in regards to which projects the Community Attendees were willing to support.

The attached list reflects all requested items that had been brought forward at the meeting along with those items that had been approved via Community Motion. It was moved by Bruce Keddy and seconded by Dale Tasker that "\$145,500 be allocated to the approved projects and that the balance of the funds be used as a contingency allowance until such time as all projects have been completed." Carried.

Mr. Scanlan thanked everyone for their active participation. The meeting was adjourned at 1:00 pm.
