RESTOULE'S LANDFILL HOURS OF OPERATION remain the same.

Summer Hours Begin: June 13th September 5th Wednesday, Saturday & Sunday 12:00-5:00p.m.

Winter Hours: January 1st – June 13th & Sept 5th – Dec. 31st Wed. & Sunday 12:00-5:00p.m.

Plus

Victoria Day – May 18th - 12:00-5:00 p.m.

Canada Day Weekend Monday – 12:00-5:00 p.m.

Civic Holiday – August 3rd – 12:00-5:00 p.m.

Labour Day – September 7th – 12:00-5:00 p.m.

Thanksgiving Weekend – October 12th – 12:00-5:00 p.m.

LANDFILL PERMITS

Permits can be purchased at the gate - **\$75.00** Residential and **\$255.00** Commercial.

Permits need to be purchased before or on August 1st, 2020.

You can and will be denied entry to the Landfill if you do not have a permit

THERE WILL BE SURCHARGE OF \$15.00 FOR PERMITS PURCHASED AFTER AUGUST 1ST, 2020

NEW INITIATIVE

- Please use Clear Plastic Bags for Household waste going into Pit
- Please do not go into Pit or Wood Pile – **NO SCAVENGING**
- Cameras have been set up to monitor dumping by the gate

RECYCLING NEWS:

WE DO NOT ACCEPT “WET WASTE” – eg. Diapers – please deposit in pit

WE DO NOT ACCEPT HAZARDOUS WASTE: Household Batteries, Car Batteries, Automotive Oils & Fluids, Paints, Antifreeze, Solvents, Insecticides, Propane Tanks,

Please Bring to Hazardous Waste Depot—112 Patton St., North Bay Open- Wed to Sat, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m

Fee has been paid by Restoule Non-Profit Landfill

NO MORE - STYROFOAM, GLASS, PLASTIC BAGS – please tie plastic bags & deposit in blue barrel

WE ACCEPT:

- **PLASTICS:** Items #1 - #7: These include-empty and rinsed, soda, detergent, water and shampoo bottles. Plastic food & yogurt containers, Tin and Aluminium cans.
 - **PAPER:** Magazines, newspaper, catalogues, phone books, flyers
- Please CRUSH all plastics and cans & FLATTEN Cardboard to conserve space in Bin**

IMPORTANT

- **NO FIRE ASHES ALLOWED IN THE LANDFILL. THEY START FIRES EVEN IN THE WINTER. KEEP FEES DOWN, IT COSTS MONEY TO PUT FIRES OUT**
- **OPEN BAGS OF RECYCLING & DUMP IN BIN LOOSE – PUT LOOSE BAGS IN BARREL**
- **PLEASE NOTE – NEW BIN IS JUST FOR PROVINCIAL PARK – DO NOT USE**
- **TIN CANS MAY ALSO BE ADDED TO METALS BIN**

ALL APPLIANCES: Stoves, washers, dryers, hot water/oil tanks

\$15.00 each

LARGE FIBREGLASS BOATS:

\$150.00 each

CANOES, PADDLE BOATS, HOT TUBS, FIBREGLASS TUB SURROUND

\$75.00 each

FURNITURE, MATTRESSES:

\$15.00 each

Note – Dismantled mattresses are exempt - fabric/padding to Household Waste Pit and springs to Metals Bin

CHAIRS WITH COVERING:

\$ 5.00 each

<u>SHINGLES</u>	(per ½ ton pickup or trailer load)	\$30.00 load
<u>TIRES</u>	Car/light truck	FREE
	Car/light truck - on rims	FREE
	Heavy Truck tires	FREE
	Loader/tractor/skidder	FREE

ODD ITEMS AND SIZES: At the Landfill Attendant's discretion

<u>BUILDING DEBRIS:</u>	Single axel truck being 7 yards.....	\$200.00
	Tandem axel truck being 10 - 14yards	\$300.00
	Tri axel truck being 18 yards	\$400.00
	Tandem Trailer 5'x10'x2' being 3.7 yards	\$100.00
	Tandem Trailer 6'x10'x2' being 4.4 yards	\$150.00
	Pick-up box 4'x8'x1.5' being 1.7 yards	\$ 50.00

***Large loads need to be approved by Landfill Committee before coming to the Landfill
The Restoule Landfill does not accept Rubble such as blocks and bricks.**
